A widely-used resource, the **CLIL Training Guide – Creating a CLIL Learning Community in Higher Education** (Morgado et al., 2015) is available at our site <http://recles.pt/>, tab>Publicações.

ReCLES.pt members joined forces in a pending Springer publication (due out in October 2018), *Teaching Language and Teaching Literature in Virtual Environments* (Carrió-Pastor (ed.), pending). “Chapter 11. **Teacher Training for CLIL in Higher Education through Blended Learning**” (Arau Ribeiro et al., 2018) examines the training course and proposes an analysis of the vicissitudes of online and classroom teaching for CLIL and the potential for interactive communication, which may be less noticeable online.

These topics were initially traced in “**Teacher Training for CLIL in Higher Education: Challenges in blended learning**” (Silva, Arau Ribeiro, Morgado, & Coelho, 2017, <https://library.iated.org/view/SILVA2017TEA>).

We look forward to the Spring volume of the CEL/ELC’s *European Journal of Language Policy*, edited by Michael Kelly. ReCLES.pt members from the Instituto Politécnico da Guarda (CILC-IPG) and the Instituto Politécnico de Portalegre (CLiC.IPP) collaborated on the article, “**Transference and Transformation for Internationalization in Higher Education: A Case Study of Portugal**” (Arau Ribeiro & Coelho, pending publication). Their analysis of EU and national legislation shows the potential effects of integrated higher education, in turn supported by the concept of *Internationalization at Home*.

This paper follows up on research for “**Internationalization strategies in Portuguese Higher Education Institutions – time to move on and to move beyond**” (Coelho & Arau Ribeiro, 2017, <https://easychair.org/publications/open/pGLj>).
